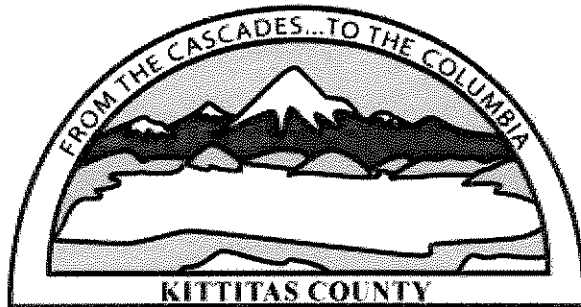


# PROCLAMATION
