**2017 State 1B/2B Wrestling Champion – 182 lb. Weight Class**





- WHEREAS:** Luke Peebles is currently a senior at Kittitas High School and a valued leader of their wrestling team; and

**ADOPTED** this 4<sup>th</sup> day of April, 2017.


