AGENDA DATE: February 7th, 2017

ACTION REQUESTED: Approve County Road Project for the Pedestrian Improvements along No. 81 Road (Clerf Rd. to Aspen Estates)

BACKGROUND: During the Open Houses held for public comment regarding the adoption of the 2017 Annual Construction Program and the 6 Year Transportation Plan the need for pedestrian improvements along No. 81 Road were identified.

Members of the City of Kittitas expressed the need for safe travel for non-motorized transportation along No. 81 Road between Clerf Road and Aspen Estates in order to allow access to the community park.

During the budget adoption process the BOCC recommended including the proposed project and adopted it as part of the 2017 budget. The project is formally included in the Annual Construction Program for 2017.

Upon CRP approval the project will be designed in 2017 and constructed in 2018. The project will be paid using county road funds.
