**AGENDA DATE:** February 21, 2017

**ACTION REQUESTED:** Approve Claim of Clayton Snyder.

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**BACKGROUND:** The claimant, Clayton Snyder, (“Mr. Snyder”) claims debris/aggregate fell off of a county vehicle and damaged the windshield and hood of his new Ford 150. The total amount of the claim is \$618.45, which is the amount Mr. Snyder claims it will cost to repair the damage to the windshield of his vehicle. Mr. Snyder says he is not making a claim for damage to the hood of his truck. Kittitas County Claim #201612290017.

**INTERACTION:** Public Works confirms the county was engaged in road operations at the time and place listed in the claim. Public Works also confirms the damage claimed is consistent with a claim of aggregate falling from a dump truck driving at 55 mph.

Mr. Snyder did not submit photos of the damage to his truck. However, he did bring his truck to the Prosecutor’s Annex for staff to inspect. There did appear to be pits in the windshield of the truck.

**RECOMMENDATION:** Public Works recommends approving Kittitas County Claim #201612290017.
