 3 hours Free Unloading Time/\$100.00 hour thereafter. Returned oil will be billed at full freight to job-site and 1/2 freight for returned product. Freight pricing based on a 30 ton min. per load. Overnight holdover - \$350.00 per night. Restocking charge of \$250.00. No credit for altered/diluted product. Job site pump-off - flat fee of \$100.00.

Western States Asphalt Notes:
 Cancellations may be subject to fees for loss of truck operation plus \$300.00 restocking fee for loads already loaded. Pumping is \$60.00 per load. Product return - \$300.00 per load. No credit given for diluted material or antistrip. Return freight - Full charge to destination and 1/2 freight back will be charged (Minimum charge on return of 20 tons). Split loads or delivery - Loads carrying two different products or loads with multiple partial unloading points will be charged an additional \$270.00 per load. Demurrage - \$100.00 per hour after 2 hours. Requests that result in loads less than the 30 ton minimum will be assessed an additional freight charge on the difference between the minimum 30 ton load and the actual tons ordered by the County.
