

Thank you for applying for a WASPC Traffic Safety Equipment Grant. We are pleased to inform you that your agency has been approved to receive \$7,000 to purchase the following equipment: (2) Speed Feedback Signs \$3,500 ea.

We were recently notified by the Traffic Safety Commission that the only stipulations pertaining to the speed feedback signs is that they should be moved a minimum of two times per year. Solar options are preferable, but not required.

The Federal Identification number for this grant is <u>CFDA# 20.600</u>. Invoices must be submitted to WASPC no later than May 5, 2017. - Report grant results to WASPC in a timely manner
- Subscribe and commit to aggressive traffic enforcement
