AGENDA DATE: July 18th, 2017

ACTION REQUESTED: Approve a Notice of Call for Sealed Bids for the Taneum Road Bridge Replacement and Washout Repair Project

BACKGROUND: The East Taneum Road and Thorp Hwy intersection has been restricted in width by concrete traffic barrier due to the failure of the existing bridge identified in late 2015.

West Taneum Road at MP 3.95 has washed out and is restricted to one lane by concrete traffic barrier since early 2016

The contract plans, specifications, and engineers estimate were prepared by Sargent Engineers for the replacement bridge and by County staff for the washout repair.

The Engineers estimate for the proposed project is approximately \$1,250,000 (\$550,000 bridge replacement, \$700,000 washout repair)

This project will install a new structure abutting an existing structure in the center of the intersection of Taneum Road and Thorp Hwy. Additionally wood studded rock revetment and hydraulic barbs will be utilized to restore the washout portion of West Taneum Road.

Bids are scheduled to be opened on August 9th, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. in the Public Works Department.

Sealed bids will be received by the Kittitas County Public Works, at the reception desk located at 411 North Ruby Street, Suite 1, Ellensburg, Washington until **10:00 AM on *** August 9, 2017 ***** and will then and there be opened and publicly read for the construction of the improvements.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid proposal deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of such bid proposal. Should the successful bidder fail to enter into such contract and furnish satisfactory performance and payment bonds within the time stated in the specifications, the bid proposal deposit shall be forfeited to the Kittitas County Public Works.

The right is reserved to reject any and all bids and to waive informalities in the bidding.

The improvement for which bids will be received is described below:

This project provides for the improvement of Taneum Road at two separate locations. East Taneum Road at the intersection with North Thorp Highway, MP 0.00 to MP 0.05, is to be improved by replacing an existing timber and concrete bridge, partially reconstructing the roadway approaches, and installing new traffic barrier. West Taneum Road, MP 3.90 to MP 3.98, is to be improved by constructing a wood-studded rock revetment along Taneum Creek to restore the creek bank and provide protection for the roadway embankment by means of clearing and grubbing, erosion control, creek diversion, excavation, slope stabilization, placing rock barbs, constructing large woody debris structures, and drainage. Improvements at both locations include traffic control and other work as detailed in the contract plans and provisions.
