AGENDA DATE: November 7, 2017

ACTION REQUESTED: Review and Acknowledge the Modification of Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Restrictive Housing Modification Requirements between the U.S. Marshals Service and the Kittitas County Sheriff's Office.

BACKGROUND: The Sheriff's Office and the U.S. Marshals Service (USMS) have had a standing agreement regarding the housing of USMS detainees at Kittitas County Corrections Center since 2010. This serves as notice of the addition of restrictive housing requirements for USMS detainees. Restrictive housing is defined as any type of detention that involves all of the following three basic elements: removal from the general population, whether voluntary or involuntary; placement in a locked room or cell, whether alone or with another detainee; and the inability to leave the room or cell for the vast majority of the day, typically 22 hours or more.

INTERACTION: The Kittitas County Prosecuting Attorney's Office has reviewed and approved.

RECOMMENDATION: Review and Acknowledge the Modification of Intergovernmental Agreement Regarding Restrictive Housing Modification Requirements between the U.S. Marshals Service and the Kittitas County Sheriff's Office.
