ACTION: Consider Data Sharing, Non-Disclosure and Use Agreement between Washington State Military Department and Kittitas County

BACKGROUND: By RCW, enhanced 911 services are a county obligation, which Kittitas County delegated to KITTCOM. Two sources are used to fund the mandate; a local \$.70 per month per access line tax and grants from the State Enhanced 911 Program Office for WAC eligible services and equipment not fully funded by local E911 tax revenue.

As the Next Generation 9-1-1 project proceeds, the technology improvements to provide the phone and location information in the Emergency Services Internet Protocol Network (ESInet) include security and other confidential & proprietary information. Included in the report is the agreement which addresses this. The agreement has been reviewed and approved as to form by the Kittitas County Prosecutor's office.

INTERACTION: Data Sharing, Non-Disclosure and Use Agreement between Washington State Military Department and Kittitas County is before the Board for consideration.

RECOMMENDATION: Authorize the Board Chairman to sign the Agreement contract with the Washington State Military Department.

HANDLING: Return two copies of the executed contract to the Military Department along with a signature page.
