AGENDA DATE: December 19, 2017

ACTION REQUESTED: Request to Approve the Replacement of Twelve Taser Units in the Kittitas County Corrections Facility.

BACKGROUND: The Kittitas County Sheriff's Office needs to replace the Tasers in the jail, as ours are outdated and no longer supported for replacement or repair. The replacement agreement will:

- Save us \$600 in training supplies in 2018, as each unit comes with 2 training cartridges at no extra cost.
- Credit us \$1200 for the old units (\$100/unit, twelve units total).
- Include enough holsters and XPPMs for use for all potential staff/inventory needs to replace broken and worn out parts over the life of the units.
- Includes Conducted Energy Weapon (CEW) hardware extended warranty coverage, CEW products, and CEW accessories as listed in the quote provided by Axon.

Additionally, the replacement of the Taser units early in 2018 will allow Corrections to conduct a transition/recertification course to introduce officers to the new units coinciding with the issuance of them.

INTERACTION: This professional services agreement was reviewed and approved by the Kittitas County Prosecutor's Office.

RECOMMENDATION: Request to Approve the Replacement of Twelve Taser Units in the Kittitas County Corrections Facility.

HANDLING: Please return both sets of signed originals back to KCSO. We will send them to be signed by the vendor, and will return one fully executed set of originals to the BOCC/Clerk for County records.
