Washington State Department of Health Continues COVID-19 Vaccine Recommendation

The Washington State Department of Health (DOH) continues to recommend that everyone 6 months and older, including pregnant people, receive the current COVID-19 vaccine. DOH is following recommendations via the Washington State Vaccine Advisory Committee (VAC).
