WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Kittitas County Fire District No. 1 has been made aware that Warrant 351415287, issued to Airlift Northwest, vendor number 08086, on 2/25/2026, in the amount of \$1,104.00 has not been received by the payee.

WHEREAS, as of the date of this resolution, the warrant has not been received by the payee and has not been presented for redemption; and


WHEREAS, the District desires to establish a defined process to cancel and reissue the warrant if it is not received within a reasonable timeframe; and


WHEREAS, the District requires the payee to complete a Lost Warrant Affidavit prior to reissuance of payment;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISISONERS OF KITTITAS COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT NO. 1, AS FOLLOWS:


- 1. CONDITIONAL CANCELLATION AUTHORIZATION:** If warrant 351415287, issued to Airlift Northwest on 2/25/2026 has not been received by the payee as of April 1, 2026, the District Secretary is authorized to initiate cancellation of the original warrant.
- 2. AFFIDAVIT REQUIREMENT:** Prior to reissuance of payment, Airlift Northwest must complete and return a Lost Warrant Affidavit, affirming that the original warrant has not been received and will not be negotiated if subsequently located.
- 3. REISSUANCE OF WARRANT:** Upon receipt of the completed affidavit, the District Secretary is authorized to issue a replacement warrant for the same amount as the original payment.
- 4. NULLIFICATION CLAUSE:** If the original warrant is received by the payee on or before April 1, 2026, or at any time prior to the cancellation and reissuance process being completed, this resolution shall be considered **null and void**, and no further action shall be taken.
